Gyimah objects to the hard runway at Redhill Aerodrome

Sam Gyimah MP has condemned the application for a hard runway at Redhill Aerodrome. Commenting today Mr Gyimah said:

“The proposed hard runway is completely inappropriate for the area. Not only would it create an unacceptable level of noise and pollution for local people but it would destroy the landscape as we know it. I am fully behind the residents in condemning this application.

“I am obviously appalled that once again Redhill Aerodrome Limited has submitted another inappropriate application for a green belt site. It causes an incredible amount of stress and worry for locals, which is frankly unnecessary.

“They are opportunistically hiding behind the Governments growth agenda to make their latest application about jobs. But this is not a fresh application; we have seen many such submissions over the years. There are no special circumstances to consider as nothing has changed, their agenda is the same.

“I am 100% behind the residents in fighting this application”
